Royal Air Force Association Tea for Heroes 4 A traditional British black tea blend.

Rare Earl Grey 4 A single-estate black tea enhanced with pure bergamot oil from Italy.

Cloud Tea 8 Floral and bright black tea with deep, malty notes, hints of chocolate and apricot. Sourced from the cloudy hills between Assam and Darjeeling.

Misty Green 4 Sourced from the mountains of Jinhua in China.

White Tea

Silver Tip Jasmine 6 A delicate white tea crafted entirely from spring buds and scented over six nights with fresh jasmine flowers.
